**Newly Added Ayurved (BAMS) Colleges and
Schedule for Special MOP UP Round for BAMS/BHMS/BUMS Courses**

Admission process of NEET-UG-2022 (Group - B) courses has started and MOP UP Round of admission was completed on 11/01/2023. **Preferences for Newly permitted Colleges** was not included during the preference filling process conducted previously.

As per information brochure for NEET UG 2022 the preferences filled during mop up round were to be used for subsequent rounds. However, in view of newly permitted colleges and Special MOP UP Round being conducted by AACCC it is decided to conduct Special MOP UP Round for allocation to newly permitted colleges and available vacant seats. Accordingly it is decided to allow fresh preferences for Special MOP UP Round in State Counseling.

All the desirous candidates who have filled the preferences for Group -B courses are hereby informed that he/she can fill new/fresh **preferences including choice for newly permitted colleges in Special MOP UP Round** by using his/her login id and password, on the web site www.mahacet.org as per the schedule mentioned below.

Instructions for Candidates for Choice/Preference Filling in AYUSH (Group B) for Special MOP UP round.

- 1) New colleges are added in the preference list.
- 2) Candidates who are willing to participate in Special MOP UP round shall fill fresh preferences as per the schedule.
- 3) Candidates who have NOT REPORTED/Cancelled the allotted college of the MOP UP round should fill in choices during this round. Such candidates if fail to fill the preference during this round will not be considered for allotment.
- 4) Candidates who have joined and filled Status Retention during MOP UP round and now wish to cancel the Status Retention Form and participate in this round shall fill the choice during this round.
- 5) Candidates who have filled Status Retention form during MOP UP round should note if they do not fill preference during this round, their Status Retention Status will not be cancelled.
- 6) Candidates who have Joined and not filled Status Retention can also fill in choices in this round. If any such candidates fail to fill choices during this round it will be deemed that such candidate do not want betterment and the seat will be auto retained.
- 7) Candidate who were not allotted any college up to MOP UP round can also fill in choices in this round. If any such candidates fail to fill new choices, the choices filled during MOP UP round will be considered for allotment.
- 8) Candidates who have Joined Status in AIQ (State) and those whose name appears in the list of not eligible candidates for State counselling published by AACCC will not be eligible for this round and any subsequent round.
- 9) Candidates who have filled Status Retention Form upto CAP round 2 are not eligible for this round and any subsequent round.
- 10) All candidates should note that it is mandatory to join the allotted college during this round.
- 11) Candidates selected during this round will not be eligible for any subsequent round(s) and there will be no further betterment in subsequent rounds.
